Summer is here and that means it's time for the Summer Reading Challenge! This year's theme is All Together Now / Todos Juntos Ahora. You're invited to gather for reading opportunities and plenty of fun activities at Washoe County Library, and beat the summer slide! All ages can sign up and participate to earn free books and a book bag. Use the Beanstack app or get a bingo log at your favorite Washoe County Library location (see pages 12-13).

We continue to meet our goal to provide welcoming spaces with the completion of our latest library renovation project at the Sierra View Library. The popular branch, which opened in 1987, is now open with updated paint, flooring, and furniture. Access to the library has been enhanced with a new back entrance and an ADA-accessible lift. It's an exciting change and we invite you to come see it in person. Also back in business is the popular Friends of Washoe County Library book sale, returning this summer (visit washoelibraryfriends.org or see the back cover for dates and times).

This year, even more exciting changes are in the works. We're adding two new Library To Go book kiosks at Sun Valley Park and the Cold Springs Community Center. These self-service library machines allow anyone with a Washoe County Library card to discover and check out popular materials. We are also finalizing our new bookmobile, with plans to be on the road and ready to go later this year.

From July 7 through August 18, the Northwest Reno Library will host *Americans and the Holocaust*, a traveling exhibition from the American Library Association (ALA), in collaboration with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. We invite the community to take advantage of a full itinerary of events scheduled around the exhibit, which includes a reception event on Wednesday, July 12 (see page 5).

Summer brings lots of opportunities to find your favorite librarians in the community. From June 1 through August 10, join us for Story Time at the Wilbur D. May Arboretum every Thursday at 10 am. We'll also be back for the Northern Nevada Pride parade and Festival on Saturday, July 22, and our popular Drag Story Hour returns this year with RainbowFest at several locations in June and July. 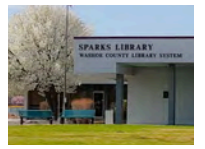

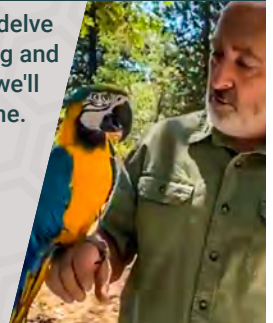

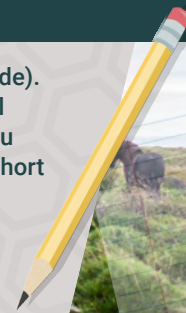


WRITE LIKE AN ANIMAL with local author Terri Farley

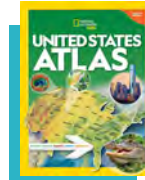

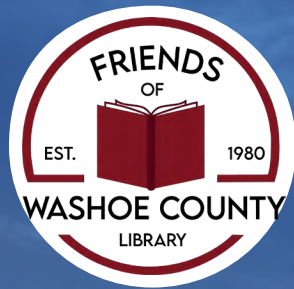

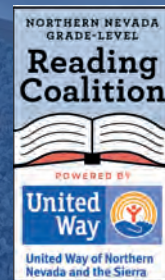
