GHOST CRAFT

Supplies

- Purple and Black Paint
- Paper Plate for a Palette
- Pencil with a Flat Eraser
- Printable Ghost Sheet or Make Your Own Cutouts
- Scissors
- Plain Paper
- Painters Tape
- Black Marker

Instructions

Print out the free printable ghost sheet and cut them out. Choose two or three and tape them to the paper using painters tape so they won't tear when you take them off. Squirt a glob of purple and black paint on your paper plate and dip the pencil erasers in it. First, go around the outline of the ghosts making sure to cover them completely. To get the faded look just dot the eraser until the paint disappears.

After they are done stamping, carefully pull off the white ghosts and draw their faces with the black marker! Boo!



Tangerine pumpkins



Ingredients:

Tangerines (seedless Mandarins or Clementines)

Celery stalks with leaves

Directions:

1. Peel the mandarins. Remove as much of the white(pith) membrane as possible.
2. Wash and dry the celery.
3. Cut 1 to 2-inch narrow pieces from the top of the celery. Insert into top of mandarin--this will be the pumpkin's stem. Use the leaves from the celery stalk and put them next to the stem--this will be the pumpkin's leaves.
