

Star of David Painting

Holiday Craftapalooza

This simple Hanukkah craft, presented by Amanda from Sierra View Library, is part of our Holiday Craftapalooza program as seen on Facebook, December 9-13, 2020.

Step-by-step instructions

Step 1: Place your tape on your paper.

Tape two overlapping triangles to make your Star of David.

Step 2: Paint the whole sheet of paper with the colors of your choice.

Be sure to paint over all the painter's tape..

Step 3: Let dry for about an hour.

Step 4: Carefully peel off the painter's tape.

Step 5: Use a crayon or marker to outline your star, adding contrast..

Optional additions:

Sprinkle salt over the watercolor paint while it is still wet. Brush off the salt when dry to create a speckled effect that looks like stars or snowflakes.

Cut the star out and tape a craft stick behind it. Or tape on a piece of string and hang it on the wall.

Make 'Snow Paint': Combine 1/2 cup white glue (PVA/ runny school glue) with 1/2 cup of shaving cream in a bowl and mix together until it looks like thick, whipping cream. Sprinkle in silver glitter and stir through. Use this instead of watercolors or over the top of your dried watercolor paint. It dries puffy and sparkly!
