Welcome to another event-full season at Washoe County Library! Our Explorer is once again packed with information on everything going on this Spring for kids, teens, and adults. We have something for everyone, including a great lineup of musical and cultural performances from Pioneer Center Youth Programs and Bright Star Touring Theatre (see pages 6-7).

Along with the Downtown Reno Library Branch Manager and staff, I was pleased to welcome the public back to our iconic Center Street location in February, following work on the building's aging elevator infrastructure. Dating from the building's 1966 opening, the elevator experienced frequent outages that created recurring challenges for any patrons unable to use the stairs. As this issue goes to press, final work on the elevator is still being completed and we can all look forward to easy and reliable access to the library's multiple levels for patrons with limited mobility.

Also in February, I joined library Outreach Team members to unveil Library on the Go, Washoe County Library's new bookmobile! This grant-funded vehicle was delayed by supply chain issues following the pandemic, and we are all excited to once again offer such a valuable service to our community. Library users were able to check out books from the bookmobile at the Cold Springs Family Center on February 9 – the first time since our last bookmobile was decommissioned in January 2010. This spring, we will be popping up around town at school and community outreaches, and regular service routes will begin in the summer.

The Library on the Go bookmobile joins our homebound delivery service and our Library to Go book-lending kiosks as part of our expanded efforts to reach Washoe County residents who cannot make it to one of our branches.

This November, you will have the chance to vote on renewing funding for Washoe County Library System. The Library Expansion Fund, approved by voters in 1994 for a period 30 years, originally allowed the library to build the Northwest Reno, Spanish Springs, and South Valleys Libraries. The fund has since provided the opportunity to renovate most of our other locations, weather periods of budget reductions, and expand services, hours, and collections at all of our libraries. Washoe County Library is partnering with the American Heart Association to bring self-monitored blood pressure kits to the library system. Included in each kit are American Heart Association-guided materials, such as a validated monitor and cuff, instructions about how to take your blood pressure at home, what those numbers mean, a log for recording numbers, a list of local health care providers ready to answer questions, and wipes to sanitize the equipment.

Renew Washoe Libraries - Did You Know?

In 1994, Washoe County Library Director Martha Gould had the vision to expand Washoe County Library System. Watching Las Vegas-Clark County Library District pass a major bond issue for building and renovating their libraries, she believed Washoe County could do the same. She developed a tax override plan that would enhance libraries and library services in Washoe County for the next 30 years.

This initiative would direct Washoe County to give Washoe County Library System two cents from every \$100 in assessed property value in the county. With these two cents, the library would plant the seeds of growth over the next 30 years.

Originally passed in 1994, Washoe County Library System took advantage of this expansion fund to accomplish:

- Building the Northwest Reno, South Valleys, Incline Village, and Spanish Springs Libraries.
- Assisting Washoe County Library in weathering the economic recession of 2008-2016.
- Renovating the North Valleys, Downtown Reno, Northwest Reno, Sparks, and Sierra View Libraries.

Thirty years later, this essential funding is set to expire. The renewal of the the expansion fund for the next 30 years will help us to maintain the award-winning, outstanding library service Washoe County residents have come to enjoy. To learn more, please visit washoelibrary.org/expansionfund

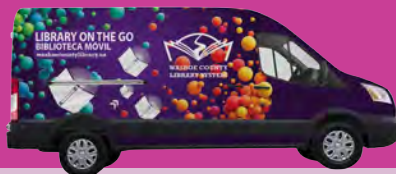


Nevada Reading Week Embrace the Magic of Reading
