#### **Treasure Hunt**

#### A Game for Two

#### Rules and game play:

- 1. Plot your treasure by drawing an outline of each item on the grid according to its size. For example, a Sunken Ship is five blocks, but Three Bags of Gems is three blocks. Treasure may not overlap.
- 2. Take turns hunting for treasure by calling out plot points for example: A-5 or J-3. Mark your attempt as a hit (X) or a miss (O) on your treasure hunt grid according to your opponent's reply.
- 3. When your opponent calls out a grid to you, answer hit or miss, according to their attempts. Mark your found treasure with an X on the "my treasure" grid.
- 4. When the treasure is found, you must inform your opponent that they found it and which item they found, for example, "You found my treasure map!".
- 5. The first person to find all their opponent's treasure wins the game.
- 6. To reuse the game sheet, you could either use pencil marks, or you could make tiny little balls of paper and foil. The paper balls would be miss (O), and the foil balls would be hit (X). You could also use two different colors of pony beads or fuse beads, if you have any at home.


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












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
